- Sting, born in 1951, is a British singer, songwriter, and actor, who gained popularity as the lead singer for the British rock trio the Police during the late 1970s and early 1980s Sting is also regarded for his subsequent career as a solo recording artist, bandleader, and actor.
- Born in Wallsend, England, Sting received training in classical piano and taught himself to play the guitar as a child. While pursuing a career in teaching, he played the bass in jazz groups and began singing. In 1977, however, he turned to music as a full-time profession.
- Active in politics, Sting toured as a solo performer with Amnesty International in 1988 and became involved in efforts to save the Brazilian rain forest in 1990. In 2003 he was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and published a volume of memoirs, Broken Music. In 2007 the Police reunited for a performance at the Grammy Awards and
